SPD POLICY MEMO #FY09-002

Audit/Review Required for Procurement Code Violations over \$100,000

Effective immediately, and consistent with Legislative Finance Committee recommendations, the State Purchasing Division (SPD) will not process any potential Procurement Code violation over \$100,000 until that potential violation has been investigated by the agency's internal auditor or Inspector General. If the agency does not have either function in-house, then the investigation must be conducted by an independent third-party auditor or accountant paid for by the agency. A copy of the written findings, with supporting attachments as appropriate, must be submitted to SPD before a determination will be made. At a minimum, the report should provide the detailed specifics of the situation and the root cause(s) as well as planned corrective action. Additionally, the report should address whether the amount billed by the contractor is fair and reasonable and explain the basis for the finding(s). This policy memo reflects a coordinated State Purchasing Division and Department of Finance and Administration/Financial Control Division position.
